At the Dawn of the 2021

I wish to celebrate from my heart that we have all been able to welcome in this new year.

This will be a year when we, the citizens and business people of Yokohama, will all join forces to strive toward achieving a safe and secure life for ourselves and the continued growth of our city into the future in a society where we will be coexisting with the new corona virus. We will also be putting energy into further urban development in the Kannai and Kangai districts and into revitalizing Yokohama's suburban districts. At the same time, we will be moving ahead on IR (integrated resorts), a national undertaking that will help sustain our future economic growth, while continuing feasibility studies into the construction of a new theatrical center for the city. Across the board we are putting in place measures for alluring city planning, and for Yokohama's sustainable development.

The city of Yokohama has come this far by working simultaneously to strengthen our countermeasures against the new corona virus and revitalize our city's economy. Going forward, we are resolved to continue to pour energy into municipal

Home-delivery service launched!

Mikawaya Roku-chan (Minamikawa Shop Association in Kanazawa Ward)

When the stay home recommendation was issued in April due to the spread of new coronavirus, it became harder for, in particular, the elderly and families with children to go out. The service - called Mikawaya Roku-chan - delivers food and commodities to individual homes on behalf of shops on the shopping street. The service does not rely on any existing commercial delivery system or company; rather, the community itself provides it, drawing on local power.

Shopping Street Shares Hygienic Measures with Local Community!

Shopping street hygienic measures (Totsukajuku Honobono Shop Association in Totsuka Ward)



This shopping street uses equipment to produce acidic electrolytic water (disinfectant), something that can also be done at home. The water is distributed to shops on the street and used to create an environment where people can enjoy shopping with peace of mind. The association also donates the disinfectant to elementary and junior-high schools in the area. Like a wave, prevention of infection is moving from the street into the community.

New Coronavirus Countermeasures Economy and Daily Life

(December Supplemental Budget)

A fourth supplemental budget for "Economy and Daily Life," totaling ¥4.4 billion, was approved in December 2020, following previous ones in May, June and September. The City of Yokohama will endeavor to strengthen countermeasures to control the spread of coronavirus infections, provide medical care, support business activities to reinvigorate Yokohama's economy, and improve the lives of citizens in distress.

Protecting Our Citizens and Our Medical System

To strenathen responses to patients with fever in winter

- To improve systems for treating or testing patients with fever, suspected of infectious disease, at emergency clinics open on
- To enable the Yokohama New Coronavirus Call Center to operate 24 hours a day and to increase the number of lines from the current 40 to a maximum of 80. X Telephone number to contact the call center is on the cover page.
- To strengthen the testing system of the Yokohama Active Epidemiological Investigation Team (Y-AEIT)
- To improve testing systems to deal with the increasing number of people who are tested at simplified sampling stations.

To strengthen activities to improve security and safety at nurseries and elderly facilities

- To support nurseries and the like in reopening after temporary closure due to infection by providing subsidies for disinfecting the facilities and the like (subsidy rate: 3/4)
- To support use of temporary substitute care to ensure peace of mind of parents/guardians (subsidy rate: 10/10)
- To provide subsidies for PCR tests requested by individuals who are 65 years old or older, in order to be admitted to an elderly facility, including a special elderly nursing home (about ¥20,000/person, one time only)

To support tourism and MICE industries, and public cultural and artistic performances and activities in **Yokohama**

- To provide subsidies for infection prevention measures, venue fees, etc., involved in staging cultural and artistic activities (paid performances, exhibitions) (subsidy rate: 1/2, to a maximum of ¥500,000 for 1,000 audience seats or more, or to a maximum of ¥250,000 for less than 1,000 audience seats)

To support businesses supporting Yokohama's economy

- To provide subsidies to small and medium enterprises (SMEs) in Yokohama for actions (installing fixtures and furnishings, reforming interiors, etc.) in adapting to the new lifestyle (about 11,000 total cases including those under supplemental budgets in June and September).

To strengthen support for citizens in difficult circumstances

 National government's system
 For households receiving temporary special benefits for single-parent households, additional basic benefits are provided: ¥50,000 per household plus ¥30,000 for each child from the second child onward

- Yokohama's own system For recipients of the central government's temporary special benefit for single-parent households, an additional temporary benefit is provided to single-parent households that do not receive a child allowance and have experienced radical changes in their household finances: ¥100,000 per household 横浜市 家計急変 ひとり親給付金
